### PROJECT TERMS - INTERNAL

The Real-Time Innovations, Inc. (RTI) Project Terms is an exhibit to the RTI License Acknowledgment Certificate (LAC). The Project Terms specifies the particular terms and licenses that You are granted. All use is subject to the terms of the RTI Software License Agreement (SLA). In case of conflict, the order of precedence is the LAC, these Project Terms, and then the SLA. Capitalized terms that are not defined herein are defined in the SLA.

RTI offers several different Project Types:

#### 1. Research Project

A Research Project is specified in this LAC as either:

- a. A Developer License for specified User (a "User Research License") on any number of internal Projects or
- b. Any number of Developer Licenses for a specified internal Project (a "Project Research License").

A Research Project includes any number of CPU licenses for internal use on the Project(s) at the Site. Research Projects do not allow distribution of Target Applications.

To qualify for a Research Project, You must accept these terms and provide contact (lead person name, company, title, email, phone, and street address), and User (name, role) or Project (name, purpose, expected duration) information to RTI. RTI will, in its discretion, notify You if the User or Project qualifies and grant You a Research Project for an appropriate Term. If You wish to extend the Term, or if there is any change in contact, User, or Project information, You must request a new license from RTI. RTI will qualify and approve Research Projects in its sole discretion. Use of a Research Project to charge service fees, or development of an application for a customer (whether or not for a fee) is permitted only with prior explicit written approval.

#### 2. Internal End Use Project

An Internal End Use Project may develop Target Applications for Internal End Use. Users within Internal End Use Projects may use the Software for any purpose without charge. You must procure a CPU license for every CPU within the Project that executes the Software. These types of CPU licenses are available:

- a. Internal End Use CPU Licenses may be used for any internal purpose, including Internal End Use, Development, testing and staging.
- b. Workstation CPU Licenses may only be used on a machine with a display, input devices (e.g., keyboard and mouse) and single user. They may not be used for Development.
- c. Test CPU Licenses may only be used internally for testing, staging and disaster recovery. Test CPU Licenses may be used for Internal End Use not more than 20 days in a calendar year.

Internal End Use Projects may not distribute Target Applications externally to third parties or beyond the Project and Site.

#### 3. Nonprofit Project

A Nonprofit Project RTI grants You any number of Development Licenses and CPU Licenses for use on any Project wholly contained within Your Site at Your nonprofit institution. Use of the Software is restricted to internal, noncommercial, not-for-profit purposes.

RTI will qualify and approve Nonprofit Projects in its sole discretion.
